(All units must be GFCI compatible)

-120-20amps

-220-50amps-4 wire plug

- Nothing is available for 30 amp RV plugs unless you have an adapter from a 220v-50amp that changes over to a 120v-30amp RV plug
- Use 220v cords
- You must provide your own extension cords. 12 gauge wire is required on all extension cords
- One electrical cord for each appliance is required (example 1 cord per electrical appliance)
- Power strips should not be used
